

# DOG EXERCISE AREAS

## How can I exercise my dog safely?

There are a number of areas throughout the Shire of Carnarvon where you can exercise your dog. This map shows the on and off leash areas, as well as the prohibited areas. Reserves within the Shire of Carnarvon are clearly sign posted.

## Where can I exercise my dog?

The Shire of Carnarvon has designated many reserves called 'dog exercise areas'. In these areas your dog may run freely and below are a few helpful hints to help you avoid on-the-spot-fines:

- A person capable of controlling the dog must be near the dog at all times.
- Carry a leash so it can be quickly attached to gain control of the dog.
- Remove any excreta left by the dog.
- The dog must not chase or harass any other person, animal or bird.



## Excreta

Permitting your dog to excrete on a street, reserve, someone else's yard or other public place and failing to remove and adequately dispose of such excreta is an offence under the Shire of Carnarvon Local Laws relating to Dogs.

## DOG EXERCISE - OFF LEASH AREAS

1. **Pelican Point**  
Pelican point Road  
From the first beach access 1km south Binning Road, to the abluion block carpark beach access. From 9am to 6pm daily
2. **Town Oval**  
Hill St and Egan Streets
3. **Hutchinson Park -**  
Babbage Island Road
4. **Festival Grounds**  
Bastion oval  
Premier Oval is prohibited
5. **Wise Park -**  
William Street
6. **Baxter Park**  
Cleaver and West Street  
Prohibited along Fascine Foreshore  
And with children's playground
7. **Carey and McKenna Levy Area**  
Carey and McKenna Streets

**REMEMBER** the dog must always be under effective control, so if you can't control your dog then keep it on a leash.

Other than the areas listed as dog exercise areas or prohibited areas, dogs must be on a leash at all times in a public place.

This is a requirement by law of the *Dog Act 1976*.

## CORAL BAY

Dogs are required to be on a lead in all public areas within Coral Bay & Mauds Landing areas. No Dogs allowed on beaches (see DBCA for more information).

## WHERE AM I NOT ALLOWED TO TAKE MY DOG?

You cannot take your dog to the following areas under the Dog Act 1976; unless it is an assistance animal under the Disabilities Act 2006:

- Public areas where there is a sporting, community or activity or event in progress or about to commence.
- Cemeteries
- Schools, college campuses
- Public Swimming Pools
- Children's Playgrounds
- Civic Centre and public buildings

# SHIRE OF CARNARVON DOG OFF LEASH EXERCISE AND PROHIBITED AREA MAP

All dogs must be kept on a leash on public property, paths and reserves, unless in designated off leash areas shown on this map

## Dogs are Prohibited

You cannot take your dog to the following areas under the Dog Act 1976; unless it is an assistance animal under the Disabilities Act 2006:

- Public areas where there is a sporting, community or activity or event in progress or about to commence.
- Cemeteries
- Schools, college campuses
- Public Swimming Pools
- Children's Playgrounds
- Civic Centre and public buildings

## Off Leash Exercise Areas

1. Pelican Point - From the first beach access 1km south Binning Road, to the abluion block carpark beach access.
2. Town Oval - Hill St and Egan Streets
3. Hutchinson Park - Babbage Island Road
4. Festival Grounds - Bastion oval only. (NOTE: Premier Oval is a prohibited area)
5. Wise Park - William Street
6. Baxter Park - Cleaver and West Street. Prohibited along Fascine Foreshore and with children's playground
7. Carey and McKenna Levy Area - Carey and McKenna Streets
